**TTM Task Force:** FYI, there are now 25+ TTM Nurse Champions spread throughout the ED and 5 adult ICUs to assist with therapy advocacy, staff coaching and to serve as unit experts on therapeutic hypothermia. They each went through a 90 minute inservice with me to establish a baseline of knowledge. They have received (and will continue to receive) continuing education via journal articles, etc.

**TTM Nurse Champions:** Attached is the 58 slide presentation that was used for your champion training in case you would like to review. Not all slides have speaker notes, though I hope to annotate them all in the future.

**ALL:** We are moving ahead with plans to establish 2-3 TTM Trainers (with the blessings and support of Zoll) that will handle initial therapy education and new equipment inservice with new ED and ICU staff. Our initial thoughts are to have regular, announced sessions for new staff as this is not a therapy/device that should necessarily be peer-taught; uniformity of base knowledge, review of internal practice guidelines, and instruction on the various devices needed for this therapy will be covered in the Trainer-led classes. Our current trainers are Sara Kaplan, RN, CN4 in MICU and me. Two urgent tasks in the TTM program are completing the revision of the clinical practice guideline and to establish a shared TTM flowsheet in Epic; both are being addressed currently. Stay tuned for further developments!

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
