



OO2 – The current chief nursing officer’s (CNO) job description and curriculum vitae.

The Chief Nursing Officer (CNO) of the UVA Health System is Lorna Facteau, DNSc, RN. Her nursing career has spanned positions from the bedside to the classroom to the board room. Facteau leads Patient Care Services (PCS) with responsibility for more than 3,100 employees. Dr. Facteau is a member of the governing groups at the highest levels of organizational decision-making. She participates in all meetings of the Medical Center Operating Board (MCOB) and is an administrative member of the MCOB Quality Sub-Committee. She serves on strategic planning groups with the Vice President and Chief Executive Officer for UVA Health System. Her executive leadership, vision and commitment to excellence in nursing are central to the achievement of the organization’s mission, goals and priorities. Dr. Facteau is accountable for the discipline of nursing and has direct authority for the practice of every Registered Nurse in UVA Health System.
